Scope

In this document, the terms “we”, “us”, “our” and/or “Treasure Time” refer to Treasure Time Ltd. The term “you” and/or “your” refer to all service users of Treasure Time Ltd or their advocates, to whom this policy applies. Visitors to our Website

When someone visits www.treasuretime.co.uk or www.treasuretimeapp.co.uk we use a third party supplier, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out such things as the number of visitors to various parts of the site. The information is processed in a way which does not identify anyone. We do not make, and do not allow Google to make any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website. If at any point we do want to collect personally identifiable information through our website, we will be upfront about this. We will make it clear when we collect personal information and we will explain what we intend to do with it.

Subscribers to our Newsletter

As part of the registration process for our newsletter or to get access to our downloadable content, we collect your email address. You can also add in other personal information such as your first name and surname if you choose, however this is not essential and can be updated or removed at any time. We use your email address to tell you about Treasure Time, our services, provide support and ideas, and give you relevant news. We may also contact you on occasion to check our records are correct or to seek your feedback and make sure that you're satisfied. We do NOT rent or trade email lists with any other organisations or businesses.



We use a third party provider, Mailchimp, to deliver our newsletter / email communications. We gather statistics around email opening and clicks using industry standard technologies to help us monitor and improve our newsletter. For more information, please see [Mailchimp's Privacy Notice](#).

Registrants for Training or Events
